

# LA CASA DE VICTOR

Calle de Enriqueta Lozano, 22 – 2º B


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We are right in the center, only a 5 minute walk from Puerta Real (Fuente de las Batallas) which is considered the central point of town. Getting to Puerta Real is always easy and if you are lost or in doubt anyone can help you finding your way as everyone in town knows where it is.

Buses from the Airport, from the Railway Station and from the Bus Station they all stop at Acera del Darro (just a few meters from Puerta Real). Across the street from the bus stop there is Acera del Casino Square (also known as Fuente de Las Batallas) then you have Campillo Square and then Mariana Pineda Square. The three squares are in a row and each has its own fountain. When you get to the end of Mariana Pineda Square look for Café Fútbol, a well-known local place. To the left of Café Fútbol is Los Marianos Restaurant. Our Street is the one to the left of Los Marianos, you will see the sign with the name of the street on the left wall. Walk one block until you get to street Mirasol. Here you will see Loes Hairdresser on your left and in front of it to your right is our front door; it is marked with number 22 on top of it. Outside the door, in the street, there is a set of ring-bells. Ring the bell that reads 2 B (that stands for second floor, door B) so that we can open the front door for you. Once inside go upstairs to the second floor or take the elevator.



**To get to Puerta Real follow directions below depending on where you are coming from:**

## FROM THE AIRPORT TO PUERTA REAL

There is only one bus from the Airport to the centre of Granada. It does not have any number, it just says GRANADA – AEROPUERTO so there is no mistake. There will always be a bus waiting for you after landing in Granada. Buses from the airport do not have any schedule, they simply wait for passengers so if the flight is delayed the bus will just wait. The price is 3 Euros (updated December 2018). Get off at “Acera del Darro / Fuente de las Batallas” which is the next stop after the Cathedral. If not sure, ask the driver. Then follow directions from Puerta Real above. Alternatively, a taxi from the airport to our front door would cost you about 28 Euros. Time to get to my place by taxi, 30 minutes: Time to get to my place by bus (60 to 90 minutes minutes)

## FROM THE RAILWAY STATION TO PUERTA REAL

The most convenient way is by bus. Go straight up Avenida Andaluces from the Railway Station (500 meters) onto Avenida de Constitución. On your right, on Avenida de Constitución, you will see the stop for bus number 4. This is a special fast line which runs every 5 minutes or so and for which you have to buy the ticket from the machines on the platform before getting on the bus. Otherwise, you can get a fine. These buses have a screen inside showing the name of the stops. Get off at “Fuente de las Batallas” and from there follow the directions from Puerta Real on top of this page. The estimated time to get to my place by bus is 25 minutes.

The Railway Station is 2.5 kilometres away from the centre. It is safe to walk all the way from the Railway Station to our place even at night but please note it will take you about 30 minutes without luggage and most probably around 45 minutes with heavy luggage. Alternatively, a taxi from the Railway Station would cost about 7 Euros. Estimated time to get to my place by taxi: 10 minutes

## FROM THE BUS STATION TO PUERTA REAL

The Bus Station is outside town about a 90-minute walk from the centre. Please note that the Bus Station itself is safe but the neighbourhood around it is not and some streets in that area could be dangerous at night. I do not recommend you walk from there at all. Please save money on other things and take the bus or a taxi to the centre.

Bus 33 is the only direct bus from the Bus Station to the centre. Buy the ticket on the bus from the driver. Get off at La Fuente de las Batallas (Acera del Darro, 40) and from there follow the directions from Puerta Real on top of this page. Estimated time to get to my place by bus is 45 minutes. Alternatively, a taxi from the bus station would cost you about 10 Euros. Estimated time to get to my place by taxi is 15 minutes.

## BY CAR

If you have your own **WEELS** please note that SOME of the streets in our area are only for residents, and parking in our street is not only forbidden (not even to drop off your luggage) but physically impossible as the street is very narrow. Also note that there is nowhere in the centre where you can park in the street for free. That leaves you with two options. You can park your car outside the centre and then walk for about 15 minutes (which I think is the wisest option) or you can leave your car in a car park near the flat. If you go for the later here you have two recommendations:

**Parking Puerta Real** (4 minute walk from the flat) is the easiest to reach and it is big and modern, but it is expensive, it costs 22,80 Euros per 24 hours (price was updated on December 7<sup>th</sup>, 2018). To get to this car park follow directions to Puerta Real below or let your GPS guide you.

**Parking Plaza de los Campos**, in Plaza de los Campos, is also 4 minute walk from the flat. It is the cheapest car park in the centre. It costs 19,50 Euros per day but you will get a 3 Euro discount per day when I put my stamp on your ticket, so the actual price for you would be 16,50 Euro per day. Just don't forget to ask me to stamp your ticket. Because of the many one way streets in the neighbourhood it can be quite difficult and tricky to get to this Car Park so you will definitely need a GPS. Its coordinates are [37.172633, -3.595376](https://www.google.com/maps/place/37.172633,-3.595376).

If you don't have a GPS to get to Puerta Real by car take highway A-44 / E-902 to Motril and take turn off number 131 (Palacio de Congresos / Armilla). If you are coming from Motril take turn off number 132 instead. 500 meters pass the Conference Centre turn left and cross the river at "Paseo Del Salon" into "Acera del Darro" and then "Puerta Real".

If you want to find a free space in the street for your car I recommend you go to the southeast area across river Genil from the centre. To get there follow the same directions above but ignore the bridge on the left after the Conference Centre and continue along the river on "Paseo de los Basilios", then turn right onto "Callejon del Pretorio" and start looking for a free space. Always keep the river behind you. The further from it the greater your chances of finding a space will be (Have a look at the map below). You can park for free in all the streets in this area south of the river (not just Callejon del Pretorio)

Expect a 10 to 20 minute walk from the car to the B&B depending on how far from the river you found a space for your car and don't forget to write down the name of the street where you left your car ;-)
